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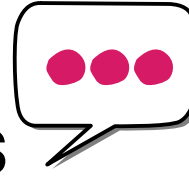

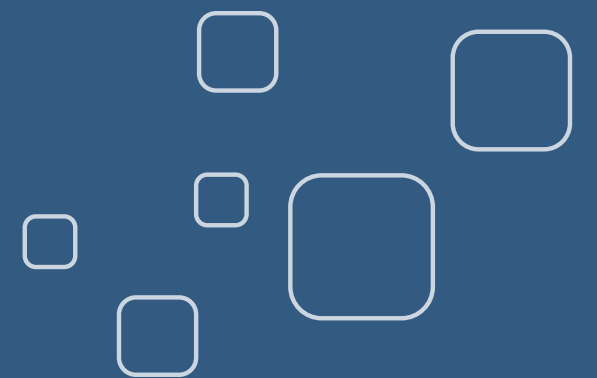

Accordingly, student projects are constantly challenged to think innovatively, creatively and systematically in order to find new solutions.



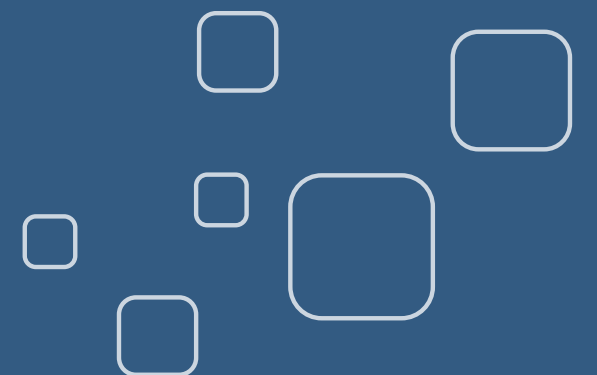
CMDT's Educational Philosophy
