Subject: Cancellation of Announcement and
The Scholarship for Accepted Students through Admission to Study
Creative Media and Digital Technologies (International Program)
For Applicants with a Certificate of Award (Digital Gifted)

To ensure proper resource allocation and operations at Prince of Songkla University International College (PSUIC), the previous announcement regarding scholarships for students admitted to the Creative Media and Digital Technologies (International Program) through the Certificate of Award (Digital Gifted) pathway—originally dated April 1st, 2024, and November 4th, 2024—is hereby canceled. Please disregard those earlier announcements and refer to the updated details below.

1. This announcement is called “The scholarship for accepted students through admission to study Creative Media and Digital Technologies (International Program) for Applicants with a certificate of award (Digital Gifted)”

2. This announcement is effective from the academic year 2024 onwards.

3. This scholarship shall be disbursed from the PSUIC Research Fund.

4. Qualifications

4.1 Applicants who are accepted through admission as a first-year student under the Bachelor of Science in Creative Media and Digital Technologies (International Program).

4.2 Applicants who have the following qualifications

4.2.1 Portfolio related to digital media or art that shows creativity and the applicant’s ability to produce artistic work.

4.2.2 Award certificate(s) that demonstrate the success of applicants in the digital media creation contest both at the regional level and/or educational district level onwards.

4.2.3 Any English proficiency test score validity within two (2) years after the test date as follows;

- IELTS ≥ 5
- TOEFL
- ITP ≥ 500
- Internet- based ≥ 61
- TOEIC ≥ 600
- PSU-TEP $\geq 65\%$
- Other scores that are equivalent to IELTS 5

5. Amount of Scholarship

One scholarship means PSUIC shall waive the PSUIC full-time tuition fee for a period not exceeding eight (8) semesters from the first academic year that applicants enroll as PSUIC students.

6. Criteria for Consideration of Scholarship Applications

Round 1: Written Exam, 100 points.

Round 2: Interview, 100 points

1. Portfolio	50	Assessment standards must score more than 80 percent of the full score in each criterion.

7. Conditions for Receiving Continuous Scholarships

7.1 In order to receive the continuing second-semester scholarships, the scholarship recipient's performance in the first semester must meet the following criteria. The consideration process is in Appendix A.

7.1.1 Registration credits of not less than 15 credits each semester from Years 1-3, not less than six (6) credits in Year 4.

7.1.2 Receiving a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of not less than 3.50 at the end of the first semester. The grade of each course must not be below C or be an F or U symbol.

7.1.3 Participating in activities and performing tasks assigned by PSUIC, including public relations, communications, marketing, and other relevant activities, for at least 50 hours per semester.

7.2 In order to receive the continuing academic year scholarships, the scholarship recipient's performance in the second semester must meet the following criteria. The consideration process is in Appendix A.

7.2.1 Participating in competitions or presenting their work, which they must submit or participate in work teams that submit to national, international, or regional competitions. They are required to present at least one (1) piece of work to the PSUIC scholarship committee per academic year.

7.2.2 Registration credits of not less than 15 credits each semester from Years 1-3, not less than six (6) credits in Year 4.

7.2.3 Receiving a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of not less than 3.50 at the end of the second semester. The grade of each course must not be below C or be an F or U symbol.

7.2.4 Participating in activities and performing tasks assigned by PSUIC, including public relations, communications, marketing, and other relevant activities, for at least 50 hours per semester.

7.2.5 Presenting their work at the Thailand International College Consortium (TICC) meeting or an equivalent academic conference is required for scholarship recipients in their fourth year.

10. Termination of Scholarships at the end of semesters

10.1 In the case of receiving disciplinary punishment to suspend studies or measures awaiting punishment following the Prince of Songkla University regulations. This will be considered for granting scholarships for the continuing academic year at the discretion of the PSUIC scholarship committee.

10.2 Scholarship recipients request to transfer to another faculty at Prince of Songkla University or another university.

10.3 Scholarship recipients request to withdraw from student status or have been suspended from student status.
